Coins for Kids-Getting Started

This packet is just the beginning! Every year the National Girls Ministries office selects a project to highlight. Resources are provided such as this *Coins for Kids Fundraising Packet*, a promotional video that highlights the current missions project, and additional resources that are available at ngm.ag.org/CFK. As you introduce this year's project, help your girls make the connection about how their involvement with Coins for Kids is making a difference in the lives of girls just like them around the world!

Make a Plan

Make a plan to introduce this year's project to your girls. Use any of the available products and resources so your girls can get involved right away. Provide each girl with a **Coins for Kids Promo Card** and play the promotional video during your time together.

Set a Goal

Challenge the girls to set a goal to give for the year. Provide a time for your girls to pray and ask God what He would have them do in response to the need presented with the 2025 project. You might be surprised by what they will give! Use the *Faith Promise Cards* and the *Coins for Kids Goal Coloring Page* for girls to write out their goals. Remember, these are amounts that will exercise their faith in giving, not just what they have to give.


Get Started

Project Rescue Feature



This year, BGMC and Coins for Kids will be coming alongside Project Rescue to allow them the opportunity to build a school.

Project Rescue began in 1997. The mission of Project Rescue is to rescue women and children from slavery and trafficking through the love and power of God. All caregivers offer God's love, liberating truth, and compassionate, holistic care while working with survivors to support them on their journey toward restoration. Funds are needed to build a school that will allow kids to have a place to go for an education and training areas for learning job skills.

Project Rescue believes that all men, women, and children bearers of Christ and deserve to live their lives freely, as fully empowered daughters and sons of God.

By giving to Coins for Kids, you can change the lives of kids and help provide them with a school building and education. It costs about \$250,000 for a library and \$200,000 for a music and art studio. Our goal this year is together to raise \$450,000 for Project Rescue.

Project Rescue exists to rescue and restore lives through the love and power of God.

They accomplish this mission through holistic programs of physical, emotional, spiritual intervention, prevention, and restoration for women and children in slavery.

Intervention

Launching initiatives to build relationships and physically rescue women and children

Prevention

Creating a culture of awareness by educating families in high-risk areas and providing residential care programs

Restoration

Meeting the ongoing holistic needs of women and children to create lasting change after rescue

Butterfly Wind Chime



Materials Needed for Each Wind Chime

- Butterfly Wind Chime Kit
- Permanent Markers
- Paint
- Rhinestone stickers

You can order the kits on Amazon, ASIN number BOCF4P1F5Z

Directions

- **1.** Hand out one kit per student.
- 2. Open up all the accessories and lay them on the table.
- **3.** Decorate using either paint or permanent markers.
- 4. When dry, add rhinestone stickers.
- 5. Put the two butterfly cutouts together to make the butterfly 3D
- 6. Cut the silver wire to the appropriate length and thread it into the hole on the wind chimes and connect them to the wooden butterfly.
- 7. Hang the butterfly outside or in your house.

As you listen to the wind chime, you can be remined of the kids that Project Rescue will be helping at the school we are building. Use the chimes as a reminder to pray for the students and also for Project Rescue.

What Is the Event Theme and How Do You Use It?

Every year, National Girls Ministries releases an *National Wide Event Planning Guide* to give you intentional, focused material that is designed to strengthen and minister to girls, with a special emphasis on missions. These materials give you devotions, activities, and discipleship material to use in a variety of ways.

This event can be scheduled on any date during the year that is most convenient for your church or district. For elementary-age girls, it's a great way to launch the year and invite guests to church. The event is designed for any church to use as a girls-only event. It's a great tool for outreach to the community!

The 2025 Girls Ministries Nationwide Event theme is *Set Free*. During the Nationwide Event, girls will have a fun butterfly theme as they talk about how they can be set free from the things that try to hold them back in their walk with God.

Not only is the event fun for girls, but the *Set Free* theme ties into the Coins for Kids project this year. As the girls learn what it means to be set free, they will learn that Project Rescue helps people find freedom. Project Rescue believes that all men, women, and children are image bearers of Christ and deserve to live their lives freely, as fully empowered sons and daughters of God. Project Rescue's varied initiatives serve the purpose of rescuing and restoring the lives of those affected by exploitation.

Fundraising Ideas

January: Movie or Roller Skating Party

Divide your girls into teams. The team that brings in the most money on a designated day or over a period of days receives a movie or roller skating party!

February: Chocolate Covered Strawberries Sale

Have the girls collect orders for chocolate-covered strawberries for Valentine's Day. Encourage the girls to get together and make chocolate-covered strawberries. Wrap them in nice packaging and deliver them to the families who purchased the special treat before Valentine's Day.

March: 10-10-10 Challenge

Challenge ten girls to find ten people to give them \$10 for missions. That's \$100 for every girl who completes the challenge. Girls can call, write, use their parents' social media, or even email friends and relatives to tell them about the BGMC project they are raising money for.

April: Create a Craft

If your girls enjoy arts and crafts, there's probably something you can make and sell. Make sure to keep track of all your expenses in making an item to be sure you are selling it at a profit. Some fun ideas are Perler Bead creations, friendship bracelets, and painting pictures.

May: Human Taco Challenge

Print photos of different leaders and place a photo on each bucket. Have the girls bring in their offering and place the money in the bucket for the leader they would like to see become a human taco. At the end of the month, the leader with the most donations gets covered in taco toppings.

June: 1 in 100 Envelope Challenge

Have the girls create and decorate 100 envelopes and label the envelopes 1-100. Put them on a giant board. Ask the church members to adopt an envelope and turn in whatever the amount is on the front of their envelope. For example 58 would mean the person would turn in \$58.

July: Churchwide Garage Sale

Have the whole church bring their unused and unwanted items for a huge garage sale. Advertise around the neighborhood that all profits will go to help build a school with Project Rescue.

August: Color Run

Have a color run at your church. Girls can run a set path around the church property. Have the girls take pledges on how many laps they can do. Set a goal for every girl to get pledges of \$50 or more for Coins for Kids. Create a level structure for prizes. Have small, business-size cards with a sample script on the back for the girls to use when asking for pledges. Purchase fun color powder and have volunteers throw the powder at the girls while they are running. It helps if girls are wearing a white shirt to add to the fun!

September: Crack an Egg on Your Head Day

Sell eggs after church on a Sunday morning and allow whoever buys an egg to crack it on your head!

October: \$31 in 31 Days

Challenge each girl to raise \$31 in 31 days. Girls can earn money by doing chores, selling candy bars, asking relatives, selling homemade baked goods, selling drawings, or other ways.

November: Chores for Change

Invite every girl to raise \$100 by doing chores for family members, neighbors, and friends. November is a perfect month to help neighbors rake leaves with parental supervision!

December: Christmas Silent Auction

Invite church members to donate items to a silent auction. Hold it the first week of December and encourage families to buy items for Christmas gifts!
