<p>Today, remember that you can experience God's peace no matter what you are walking through.</p> <p>John 14:27 3</p>	<p>Do you know that you can sleep in peace at nighttime because God is protecting you?</p> <p>Psalms 4:8 4</p>	<p>Jesus promised to be with us when we go through hard things. When faced with a trial, remember the encouraging words He said in John 16:33, "...take heart; I have overcome the world."</p> <p>5</p>	<p>"Shalom" is the Hebrew word for "Peace" in Scripture. May you experience the "Shalom" of God in your everyday walk with Jesus. Pray this Scripture below over you and your family—God promises peace!</p> <p>Numbers 6:24-26 6</p>	<p>Jesus is the Prince of Peace. When you are worried, look to Him. Trust that He is able to bring peace to whatever situation you are walking through.</p> <p>Isaiah 9:6b 7</p>

<p>If you are worried today, God wants to fill you with His peace. Pray the prayer from Romans 15:13 over yourself and possibly a friend who is experiencing anxious thoughts.</p> <p>Romans 15:13 10</p>	<p>When you tell the good news of Jesus to a friend at school, Isaiah 52:7 says that you are a publisher of peace! Share the good news of Jesus, and the peace that comes with knowing Him!</p> <p>Isaiah 52:7 11</p>	<p>Do you sometimes get afraid at nighttime? Do you know that the Lord is protecting you? Read and memorize the verse below—it will help you sleep!</p> <p>Psalms 4:8 12</p>	<p>Do you know that living for Jesus produces peace in our lives? That's what the verse below is referring to. Righteousness and peace—they go hand in hand!</p> <p>Psalms 85:10-15 13</p>	<p>God desires for us to have peace in our relationships with each other. How peaceful are your relationships today? If you need help, ask for God to help bring peace.</p> <p>Romans 12:18 14</p>

<p>God can help you through any anxious thought you have. Bring your worry to Him! He'll give you peace.</p> <p>Philippians 4:6-7 17</p>	<p>Do you know that thinking on true and lovely things can help you experience God's peace?</p> <p>Philippians 4:8 18</p>	<p>God delights in those who live peacefully with other people—that means that we forgive and love the people we encounter on a daily basis!</p> <p>Matthew 5:9 19</p>	<p>The peace we have from God is not like any other superficial "peace" that the world will try to offer you. Lean on Jesus' perfect peace today!</p> <p>John 16:33 20</p>	<p>Jesus called us to make disciples of all nations—and did you know that He promised to be with us and to give us peace if we follow His command to make disciples?</p> <p>John 20:21 21</p>

You are free in Him!</p> <p>Romans 5:1 24</p>	<p>It's not about what you do for God that makes you fulfilled, it's about knowing that His presence, peace, and joy are always near!</p> <p>Romans 14:7 25</p>	<p>Do you know that one of the fruits of the Spirit is peace? That means that the closer you get to Jesus, the more peace you'll have in your life.</p> <p>Galatians 5:22 26</p>	<p>Let Christ's peace fill your heart today as you trust in Him, and think of things you can thank Him for!</p> <p>Colossians 3:15 27</p>	<p>God is your supplier of peace. Pray this verse below over yourself and your family!</p> <p>2 Thessalonians 3:16 28</p>
