Over the years, the annual donations from this fundraiser have helped to support communities, churches, and schools all over the world. This year, BGMC and Coins for Kids are coming together to support Africa Oasis and provide clean drinking water across Africa.

Africa Oasis provides bucket water filters and water education to families in Africa. These filters have been proven to eliminate over 99 percent of all contaminants and bacteria in water. One filter provides enough daily drinking water for a family of ten, and, when properly cared, for can last for a decade. This is life changing for many African families.

Africa Oasis also partners with local churches to be representatives in their communities. These churches know the language, the culture, and the people. Africa Oasis partners with church members who volunteer for this ministry and go door-to-door, distributing the filters, teaching how to use them, and sharing the message of Jesus!
