recognize honor graduates
at these events.

## Honor Recognition Guidelines

Honor Stars, Friends Graduates, Girls Only Graduates, and Medals I of Honor recipients makel application through the I district office. However, there is NO DISTRICT TESTING. All reviews must I be taken in the local church as stated in the Girls Ministries curriculum. Remember, these are national awards with national standards. The standard is a review taken at the local level with a Review Board of three members. Signatures of the Review Board and pastor are required. I Cover pages will be sent 1 to you. All Honor or Graduate applicants should receive the I national certificate I regardless of participation in a district event.

## Suggested Celebration Guidelines

We suggest recognizing Honor
Stars, Friends Graduates, Girls
Only Graduates, and Medals of
Honor recipients at the district
level. (The local church Celebrations can be prior to or
following your district ceremonies.)

Each girl is escorted in and her name, and possibly a brief bio, is given.

To conserve time, each girl can wear her awards (presented at the local Celebration).

I Present the girls by club.

I Present each girl with a gift from the district (flower, district certificate, etc.).

Give special recognition to Medals of Honor recipients.

Print and laminate the appropriate club charge for each girl.

Organize a choir to sing at the Celebration.

Conclude with a reception.
