Memory Verse: "God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son" (John 3:16).

- 3) What did Mary and Jesus give?
- 4) What can I give God?

## Growing

Memory Verse: "Be strong in the Lord" (Ephesians 6:10).

Central Truth: God helps me grow.

Clubroom Objectives:

- 1) What do I need for my body to grow?
- 2) How can I have a strong body?
- 3) How can I have a healthy body?
- 4) How can I be strong in the Lord?

## Healing

Memory Verse: "I am the Lord, who heals you" (Exodus 15:26).

Central Truth: God can heal me.

Clubroom Objectives:

- 3) Should I pray for the sick?
- 4) What should I do when I am healed?
