Your new self in Christ is a foretaste of what ultimately will come. God will make everything new at the end of times. This is your great hope – that sin, death and pain will be completely erased.

Revelation 21:4-5 11

Week 2: This Year, You are Made New

You can look ahead to this year with great expectations. God has already planned these days long ago. This is His promise to you.

Jeremiah 29:11 13

Write this verse on a card and stick it in a place where you will be reminded of this truth. On good days and bad this year, you can still have hope.

Proverbs 23:18 14

When you put your hope in Jesus, you will not be put to shame. Even in sufferings, hope is produced because of God's love through the Holy Spirit.

Romans 5:1-5 15

With hope as your anchor, you will not be moved by stormy circumstances around you this year. Be tethered to this truth – you are firm and secure.

Hebrews 6:19 16

This is our prayer over you this year. We serve the God of hope. Who in your life also needs to be reminded of this? Pray this verse over them, too!

Romans 15:13 17

Keep your eyes fixed on God this year. Watch with expectation as He answers prayer and moves in seemingly impossible circumstances.

Micah 7:7 18

Week 3: This Year, You Have Hope

God is always with you. He is actively delighting, loving, and singing over you. How does knowing this change how you interact with God?

Zephaniah 3:17 20

No matter what you face this year, you can be full of strength and courage instead of fear. With God on your side, you don't have to be afraid.

Deuteronomy 31:6 21

Not only does Jesus give us a commandment, but He also left us with a promise. When you step out to share your faith with others, He will be with you.

Matthew 28:19-20 22

When you are up against opposition this year, speak this verse over yourself. God will never let you go and will help you.

Isaiah 41:10 23

The Lord is your shepherd, comforter, protector, and provider. Do you have a friend or family member who needs to be reminded of this? Send them a card or text with this scripture!

Psalms 23 24

Wherever you end up this year, God will be the one guiding your steps along the way. Ask to hear His voice clearer than you ever have! He wants to speak to you.

Isaiah 30:21 25

Week 4: This Year, God is with You

God has prepared you in advance for what you will do this year. When you don't feel adequate for the task, He will provide the help and wisdom you need.

Ephesians 2:10 27

You do not have to fret about tomorrow because God is already there! He knows what you need and He will take care of you. Place your worries on His shoulders.

Matthew 6:25-34 28

Allow God to work in you what is good and pleasing to Him. You have a great capacity to share His love with others. Ask Him to use you in specific ways this year to walk according to His will.

Hebrews 13:20-21 29

Whenever you feel inadequate this year, just know that you are covered on all sides by the Armor of God. You can stand, equipped in His truth!

Ephesians 6:10-13 30

What characteristics are attributed to God in this scripture passage? He is the God who equips you. He is the one who trains you to be more like Him.
